# Bare Root Orchid Growing Nick Braemer Monday, May 23, 2011

Culture Class: Topic TBD Espie Quinn

Nicholas Braemer got involved with orchids when he realized in 1995 that yellow Cattleyas lasted longer than yellow roses, were cheaper, and left him with a plant that could bloom again. Since yellow roses were the favorite flowers of his significant other, a hobby was born. Nick never could do things within reason; the household was decorated with a 4,000 gallon salt water tank, the backyard zoo included a Burmese Python, rabbits, turtles, dogs, cats, geese, and a macaw, etc. The orchids went a similar course, and by 2000 there were about 500 of them. During repotting on January 1, 2000, a major hand wound prompted the decision to avoid repotting in the future, and a search was launched to find a better way of growing orchids. Numerous dead end alleys were entered and abandoned, but he persevered, and at present there are 2,000 plus orchids in Nick's backyard; none need repotting. Also, none can be over watered and all are performing in a fashion that is pleasing to him, good enough to earn the usual cubic footage of ribbons and a share of trophies for the fireplace mantel.

Nick will discuss his growing methods which center around the bare-root concept but are in no way limited to mounted, bare root plants.
