Peter Lin is a long time orchid hobbyist and recent convert to commercial growing (see www.diamondorchids.com). He always provides an interesting program, as he has demonstrated in past lectures to SCOS. He is and an accredited judge with the AOS, and often brings plants in to our meetings from the judging room to point out their award winning qualities. He has been winning AOS awards for his outstanding examples from the genus Sophronitis and related small cattleya alliance plants, and his interests span much of the orchid family, including Angraeciods, Dendrobiums, and Neofinetias.
