Culture of Deciduous Orchids and Companions by Dan Asbell, Asbell Orchids Program Starts at 7:00 p.m. Monday, June 22, 2015

What began as his dad's hobby in the early 1960's became **Asbell Orchids** in the late 1960's. It was originally a cymbidium cut flower operation, and they did their own hybridizing. Dan grew up working and learning about orchids, but got away from the business after college. Although he always had a few orchids in a personal collection, he decided to get back into the business end of things ten years ago. In the meantime, the business had relocated to Arroyo Grande (near Pismo Beach). Also the cymbidium cut flower business had been replaced with potted plants obtained by hybridizing (instead of cloning). Recent and rapid major changes have occurred in the orchid business within the last decade, so they have expanded into cymbidium "companion" plants that can grow outdoors in California alongside cymbidiums. Dan last spoke to us in May of 2013.

Dan's topic on Monday is Deciduous Orchid Culture, with an additional focus on carnivorous plants as orchid companions that will do well in the same environment. Considering how many insects are attracted by orchids, a plant that eats insects could be a useful and fun addition to your collection. Find out how on Monday.
