HAVE YOU HEARD? The famous grass skirts of Hawaii are made of nothing more than the leaves of the ti plant, or good luck plant. The ti plant (Cordyline terminalis) can be grown in your home or green house.


The real lipstick plant is Acschynanthus lobbianus and it has been recorded botanically for over 100 years. There are about 70 known species.

<u>DID YOU KNOW?</u> Greenhouse operation at this time of year requires more attention than during summer and early fall. With the onset of short, dull days and colder nights, plants have a tendency to make soft growth, thereby making it necessary to pay particular attention to ventilation, humidity and temperature.

Dripping water from condensation, drafts, sudden drops in temperature and musty, rank conditions are sure signs of trouble. A high humidity, which is of vital importance, is easily maintained by wetting down walks and unused areas under the benches. This should be done on bright days and when the regular heating has started.
