GREENHOUSE CARE: Watering can take time...how about you...have you timed your watering? A single error or omission of watering can cause more problems in hot weather. Do you have adequate provisions for watering? If you have a single spigot inside your greenhouse, is the hose long enough to reach all plants? Or do you have to take time dragging the hose around, changing nozzles and filling watering cans? Some growers feel that three different nozzles are a minimum for proper watering. 1. A pressure-breaker...applies water freely as it flows from the hose but breaks the one solid stream up into scores of tiny streams which flow without force. 2. A fog-nozzle...which converts the water into a fine mist.

3. A fan-shaped sprinkler nozzle or rose...applies water evenly to a bench. A time saver would be a shut-off at the hose end and a watering-wand.
