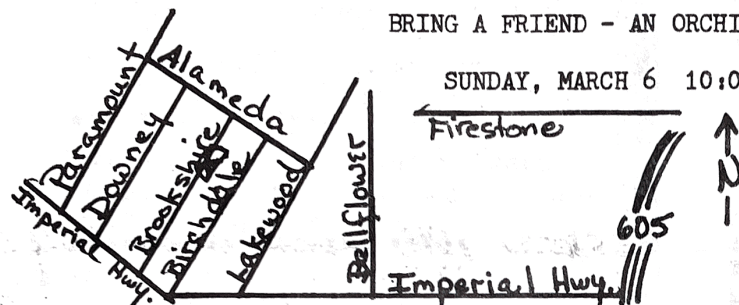


NOVICE NEWS
