SCOS and ORCHID DIGEST awards found in South Coast Orchid Society Newsletters, February, 1958-1968, and in ORCHID DIGEST 1954-1968 and other sources.

Preliminary transcript by John McCoy (RealMac@aol.com), from the "Orchid Archive" collection at The Huntington Botanical Center. Between the surviving SCOS newsletters and the lists published from time to time in ORCHID DIGEST, a fairly complete record of judging at the Long Beach site for this period can be reconstructed. In some years, there was probably no SCOS judging in January, because the meeting was held at different location (such as the Petroleum Club in Long Beach) for the annual banquet and installation of officers.

As a result of negotiations between the respective organizations, judging under the auspices of Orchid Digest Corporation was terminated at the end of 1967, and judging resumed under American Orchid Society standards in January, 1968. The standards by then were nearly identical anyway, and all ODC judges were accepted at the equivalent level as AOS judges. In fact, most of the ODC judges were already AOS judges.

The negotiations also proposed that ODC awards from the past would be recognized as equivalent to the AOS awards in effect at the time, but in the event, no action seems to have been taken to implement this idea. The effort required to reconcile all the award records from both organizations was probably too daunting. However, there was never any suggestion that ODC awards were to be treated as invalid, and there is nothing to prevent us from citing them today. They are an important part of our orchid history.

The awards published in the SCOS newsletters that have been recovered so far usually included a serial number. Another set of serial numbers (in parentheses, below, as published in ORCHID DIGEST) was used for all ORCHID DIGEST awards across all judging sites. The serial numbers published in the SCOS newsletter, pertaining only the SCOS judging site, end in December, 1967 with number 528. Additional awards, lacking serial numbers and sometimes other details, have been gleaned from ORCHID DIGEST, in the summaries of the meetings of affiliated societies, and, beginning in 1957, in the summaries of judging results at affiliated societies. The meeting summaries show that judging began at SCOS in December, 1954, following a decision by the membership two months earlier. A few additional records have been recovered from slides found in other collections.

If a complete list of the awards from the Orchid Digest Corporation judging program has survived, no one seems to know where it is. For the Long Beach site, of a series of 528 sequentially numbered awards (plus 4 additional awards noted but apparently not part of the numbered sequence), we have found the details of at least 454 of them, thus accounting for 86% of the awards conferred. Some corrections to plant names, and, in a very few cases, photographs, have been discovered, described below in [brackets].

One anomaly has been discovered in the publication of ODC awards from SCOS and OSSC in ORCHID DIGEST. While some early ODC awards from OSSC and SCOS were indeed published as valid ODC awards (for example, in the *ODC Awards List* published in 1965-1966), others

were not. Before March, 1957, the awards from SCOS and OSSC were sometimes, but not always, either not published or else published with a footnote to the effect that they were "independent", in other words, not official ODC awards. But in 1957, the ODC Directors issued a statement (ORCHID DIGEST (21(2):65, March-April, 1957) to the effect that all of the awards from SCOS and OSSC were to be regarded as equal in status to ODC awards. However, the statement did not provide any context as to whether this pronouncement was to be regarded as retroactive, or only applicable to future awards. In any case, the judging standards then in use had been developed and implemented in 1949 by OSSC and then formally adopted by ODC in 1952. The judges at all ODC judging sites were using the same standards and the same qualifications for the judges themselves, so there was no reason to treat the awards separately. The only real consequence from the period 1954-1957 is that there are some gaps in the awards that were published in ORCHID DIGEST.





That there is reason to question this information is confirmed by the discovery of a report of judging at the Royal Horticultural Hall, Tuesday, January 25, 1921 (reported in Gardeners' Chronicle, January 29, 1921): "Messrs. SANDERS, St. Albans, were awarded a Silver Banksian Medal for a group with Cymbidiums at the back and a good selection of Cypripediums and Laelio-Cattleyas. Among the best were Odontoglossum Knight Templar (amabilis x Rio Tinto), a large dark red flower, with some lighter markings; and Cypripedium Nubian (Niobe x Thompsonii), a grand flower of fine substance." Also, in the 1934 Yearbook of the Massachusetts Horticultural Society, among "Medals and Certificates Awarded in 1933", we found a "Vote of Commendation" for Cypripedium Nubian, exhibited by Edwin S. Webster – proof that Paph. Nubian was generally recognized before the supposed registration in 1934. The hybrid of Niobe x Thompsonii is now shown as Nubia, registered by W. Thompson of Walton Grange in 1912. Is it possible that Nubia was at least once mislabeled as Nubian, resulting in a "new" but fictitious hybrid? We checked the online RHS International Orchid Register, which agrees with what we found in OrchidWiz. Nubia is listed in the 1921 edition of Sander's List with the same data. Orchid Review vol. 38, p. 285 (1930) mentions "Cypripedium Nubian (parentage unrecorded), from Messrs. Sanders", a reference to the FCC award mentioned above – this is a Google "snippet", the entire article needs to be examined. Also found on Google, Orchid Review, 1949, p. 13, a discussion of "C. bingleyense" crosses: "C. Nubian is also probably a C. bingleyense cross...". Also, Sander's One-Table List of Orchid Hybrids, 1961, p. 458 (snippet view, again), "Nubian, ign. (probably a Bingleyense cross)", but there is an extra character not completely visible in the snippet, before the grex name, suggesting uncertainty, and the date is apparently uncertain as well. See also, Paphiopedilum Hybrids: Their Parents and Progeny as Registered from 1856,

Including Cypripediums and Phragmipediums, Penn Valley Orchids, 1994. One opinion (AOS Bulletin, December, 1963, p. 998) is that Paphs Redstart and Nubian both have unknown parentage but are very similar, and both are thought to be bingleyense crosses, "and in our opinion is it likely that they could be the same cross". Apparently, bingleyense was at times (1950's?) regarded as a separate species. (Note pictures of Paph. Nubian at Smithsonian Institution Learning Center web site, and Redstart 'Exbury' from mariasorchids.blogspot.com from District of Columbia Botanic Garden.)]




