

## South Coast Orchid Society – Sale 2026 – Plants donated by Janell Schuck estate, and other donations / Supplies / Books

### Sale Inventory – March 22, 2026

Plants not in good condition may be withdrawn before the sale. Not all plants have labels. Plants chosen for sale rather than auction are generally more affordable and not exceptional enough to warrant individual auction. However, there are many fine plants here, most of them well suited for outdoor growing in Southern California. Prices (preliminary prices shown here) will be clearly marked on the plants. Photos are provided wherever possible. Photos are representative unless noted as “photo of this plant”.

---

**Bletilla striata**, many blooming size divisions with large rhizomes and usually multiple growths, mostly 6” pots. Harvested from Janell’s raised planter. Most have already bloomed in the past month. \$15. Photo of our Bletilla crop a week before the sale.



**Den. Specio-kingianum album**, Janell’s label says from Paul Brecht, tall canes, large plant, white flowers, lip has very faint pink dots and yellow callus. Our inventory #JS\_009. This is *not* the awarded Specio-kingianum *yellow* cultivar called ‘Brecht’. Priced at \$40.



Also, 2 blooming size divisions of apparently the same cultivar labeled x delicatum ‘Brecht’, 4” pots, \$15.

**Den. Zip or similar**, specimen, neglected but flowering on old canes. No label, but clearly Zip or one of its hybrids, very similar to Zip Charm. \$20.

## Den. Australian Tiger

parentage is Aussie Tiger x Hilda Poxon, compact grower, many 1½” greenish-yellow flowers with red lip and irregular red edges to the segments. \$25.

## Den. x delicatum

no label, but similar to some strains of x delicatum, excellent compact specimen, **prolific bloomer**, flowers have good shape, strong pink blush, distinctive lip, flowers 1½” across, large flowers for x delicatum. \$30.

## Den. kingianum

no label, a very compact, almost miniature kingianum, canes about 3” at most, flowers with excellent bright color. \$25.

## Den. kingianum ?

specimen, tall canes, flowers have **excellent full shape**, almost pure white, very pale pink blush on the buds, little or no fragrance. \$20. Photos of this plant.

**Den. kingianum**, label says “white blush”, specimen, tall canes, smallish flowers have good shape, white with **dark purple pedicels** and some purple on back of sepals, **nice fragrance**. \$20. Photo of this plant

**Den. Regal Vista**, specimen with tall canes, many bright yellow flowers to 2” across, red lip, good example of this popular cross. \$25.



---

**Myrmecophila (Shomburgkia) tibicins**, division, several years from blooming, well established in hanging basket. Needs strong light. \$30.



---

**Cattleya SVO Sunset**, 6 seedlings, parentage is (sanguiloba x tenebrosa) x purpurata, registered by Fred Clarke in 2022. Excellent cross, intense colors. \$25.



---

**Vanda (Neofinetia) falcata**, Amami Island type, 2 specimens from Cal-Orchid crosses. \$15.



**Ansellia africana alba**, 21 divisions, numerous flowers not much over 1" across, nice yellow green, easy grower. 1 gal. \$25. Another division, in flower, is being auctioned.



---

**Laelia anceps**, 7 different seedlings, latest breeding from James and Lauris Rose (Cal-Orchid) and SBOE, all should have large, full flowers, 4" pots. \$15.



---

**Rth. (Izumi Charm x C. Angel Eyes)**, 5" seedling, compact breeding, photo is sample from SVO, not this plant. \$15.



---

**Rlc. Naomi's Delight**, several 5" seedlings, compact breeding, most of these will have strong spots. \$20.



**Gur. Hail Storm, SVO cross #9293**, 2 big seedlings in 5" pots. This is technically bowringiana x skinneri, but here the skinneri is replaced with the variety or possibly species Gur. (Cattleya) deckeri. At least as floriferous as bowringiana or Portia, very desirable. \$25.



This cross was made with coerulea parents, but the seedlings seem to be coming out purple, not blue. Genetics of blue can work that way?

**Cattleya (Caudebec x Benin)**, recent cross #10048 from SVO, bred for SPOTS. Seedling in 5" pot. \$20.



**Bc. (Binosa x C. Elegans (1879))**, 6 seedlings, good color range, vigorous plants, 5" pots. \$20.



**Rlc. Rubescent Doll x Hisako Akatsuka**, recent hybrid from SVO cross #10881, ancestry includes Purple Doll, Rubescence, and Hisako Akatsuka, all excellent compact Cattleyas with strong colors and full form. 1 seedling, 5" pot. \$25.



**Lc. Puppy Love**, SVO remake of an excellent old hybrid (C. Dubiosa (1890) x L. anceps) designed specifically for outdoor growing , 1 seedling, 5” pot. \$20.



---

**Rth. (Synda Nelson x Cattleya Angel Eyes)**, recent breeding from SVO cross #10688, wide range of colors and flares from this cross, excellent form. 1 seedling in 5” pot. \$20.



---

**Cym. Gladio x Cindy Lou**, excellent novelty green with pinkish lip, arching spikes, flowers very long lasting, ½ gal. division. \$20.



---

**Cym. Tom Thumb**, classic miniature/novelty, strongly pendant spikes, 2”+ flowers green with purple spotted lip, 1 gal. \$20.



---

**Cym. Madrid ‘Forest King’** HCC/AOS, 1970, standard flowers “apple-green”, red lip. 1 gal. #20



## **Cym. San Francisco ‘Dos Pueblos Special’** AM/ODC 1967,



classic standard, greenish-yellow with spotted lip, we have 4 1 gal. divisions for sale, plus a 3 gal. division in spike that will be auctioned. \$30.

## **Cym. Dance Time ‘e’**, an odd cultivar from a cross by Tony Velardi (Mariposa



Gardens). Spikes are strongly pendant, the flowers widely spaced, this one brownish gold with some flaring and variable spots, velvety deep maroon lip. Distinctively weird. Spike and flowers develop slowly. 1 gal. \$20.

Spikes can hang down more than 2' !

## **Cym. Peetie ‘Holmstead’**, old standard hybrid by Don Sherman 1963, we have 3 divisions, 1 gal. \$20. No photo available.

## **Cym. Golden Bean**, novelty from Andy Easton, not as golden as you might think,



more muted yellow with blush, but nice. Long arching spikes. 1 gal. \$15.

## **Cym. Dag ‘Wintergreen’**, well-known miniature/novelty hybrid by Mary Bea



Ireland 1964, named after Dag Hammarskjöld, Secretary-General of the United Nations 1953-1961. Excellent miniature/novelty, arching or pendant spikes, makes a great specimen after a few years. ½ gal. \$20.

**Cym. Pharaoh 'Regalia'**, standard white from 1970. ½ gal. \$15.



---

**Cym. unknown commercial hybrid from Home Depot,**



we call it 'Green Giant'. Big standard green with spotted lip, very strong upright spikes, vigorous grower and bloomer for the last 20-30 years! 3 divisions in 2-3 gal. pots. \$20.

**Cym. Monterey Sunset 'New Horizon'**, deep flame color, standard from Andy Easton. 1 gal. \$20.



---

**Cym. Woody Wilson 'White Knight'**, BIG white blush with spotted lip, spikes tend pendant but can be partially staked for better display, created by SCOS member Loren Batchman and named after former SCOS president Woody Wilson, 1 division. 1 gal. \$25.



**Cym. Kusuda Flame ‘Cal’**, Andy Easton novelty hybrid, deep dusky red. 5” pot. \$15.

**Cym. Summer Wildfire (Shining Pepper x Valerie**



**Absolonova**), novelty breeding from Andy Easton, expect arching spikes. Unbloomed seedling, probably good color and flower count. 5” pot. \$20.

---

**Cym. Green Bean (Golden Bean x Valerie**

**Absolonova**), novelty breeding from Andy Easton, expect arching or pendant spikes. Unbloomed seedling, likely greenish flowers, no photo available. 5” pot. \$15.

---

**Cym. Beautiful Emerald**, novelty breeding from Andy Easton. The name comes from its parentage, Sleeping Beauty x Esmeralda. Bright green with yellow lip. 5” pot. \$15.



---

**Cym. Shake Your Booty**, nice standard green from Joe Santy. 1 gal. \$25.



**Cym. Placido Domingo ‘Metropolitan’ 4N**, novelty breeding by



Andy Easton, long arching/pendant spikes, very showy deep burgundy flowers. Mericlone in 5" pot. \$20.

**Cym. Erin Nakasone**, novelty breeding by Tony Velardi (Mariposa Gardens),



Snow Court x canaliculatum. Extremely floriferous, long-lasting arching spikes with about 20 2½" flowers. 3 divisions in 1 gal. pots. \$20.

**Cym. Enzan Shining (‘#1’ 4N x ‘#2’ 4N)**, sib cross by Joe Santy,



unbloomed seedling. Photo shows the parents, which are both strongly colored, nice big flowers. ½ gal. \$25.

**Cym. Judy, Judy, Judy x devonianum**, interesting unregistered



novelty hybrid, large red-brown flowers with burgundy lip, strongly pendant spikes. 1 gal. \$20.

---

**Cym. Dance Time**, unbloomed seedling. Novelty breeding (spots) from Tony



Velardi (Mariposa Gardens), most seedlings are brownish-gold to pale green with variable burgundy spots, velvety deep burgundy lip, some have subtle sepal-peloric features. Spikes will be strongly pendant with widely spaced flowers. Photo is one of the green cultivars. 1 gal. \$20.

**Rth. Pure Love**, parentage Love Sound x C. Seagull's Apricot, SVO cross 10893, unbloomed seedling. This seedling turned out very nice! 5" pot. \$20. Photo of this plant.



---

**Rlc. Haadyai Delight x C. Candy Sparks**, new breeding from SVO cross #10756. The pod parent is a fantastic big yellow on a stocky plant, from Thailand, some seedlings have been almost pure yellow, others with colorful splash petal combinations, about 3" flowers on compact plants. 3 seedlings, 5" pots. \$20.



---

**Rchg. (Rechingerara) Galen's Gold**, created by SCOS past president Ruben Colmenares, parentage L. anceps x Rth. Guess What, a nice step toward anceps-like yellows! Many are coming out deeper yellow than this photo. 5" pot. \$20.

**Cty. Leaf Hopper**, cute "Epicat", greenish with bright purple lip. 5" pot. \$15.



---

**Bc. Binosa x C. Elegans (1879) alba**, vigorous plants, strong but variable colors. 5 seedlings in 5" pots. \$15.



**Cattleya Memoria Bishnu Subba (Hawaiian Wedding Song x purpurata)**, considering the parentage, it should be a great standard Cattleya for outdoor growing in our area! No photo available. 5" pot. \$25.

**Cattleya Fulvescens (dowiana x forbesii)**, interesting hybrid, uncommon. 5" pot. \$25.



**Rth. Zul**, parentage is Gur. skinneri x Rth. Orange Nugget, SVO cross #9547. 3 seedlings, 5" pots. \$20.



**Rchg. Smart Lady (L. anceps x Rth. Love Sound)**, another route to yellow "anceps" breeding. 5" pot. \$20.



**Cattleya tenebrosa**, SVO line breeding cross #9547 ('Bill's Choice' x 'Windflower').

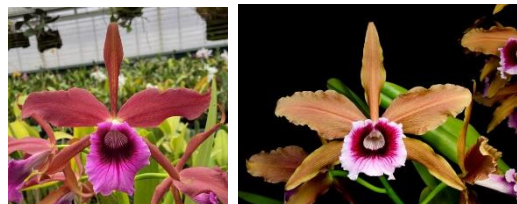

**Guarianthe deckeri (skinneri) coerulea x self**, the deckeri varieties of skinneri tend to have darker coloring, especially the lip. 5" pot. \$20.

**Cattleya purpurata carnea x self**, seedling from from Joe Ambriz. 5" pot. \$20.

**Cattleya Jackie Stidham**, SVO remake, cross #10454, nice "blue" hybrid. 2 seedlings in 5" pots. \$20.

**Cattleya Loddiglossa x Bct. Little Mermaid**, nice sorta compact hybrid from SVO, cross #10677. 2 seedlings in 5" pots. \$20.



**Lc. Miss Wonderful.** Another remake by SVO, cross #10682, excellent. There are many cultivars of Miss Wonderful, varying considerably in form and color. 2 seedlings in 5" pots. \$20.

**Guarianthe bowringiana coerulea x self**, orizalin treated, SVO cross #10670, thus potential for 4N plant, and in any case, probably a very good bowringiana. 2 seedlings in 5" pots. \$20.

**Ctt. Chocolate Drop**, great old hybrid (Stewart, 1965), remake by SVO cross #10667. 5" pot. \$20.

**Bc. Richard Mueller x Ctt. Orchidglade**, SVO cross #10684, some strong colors and lots of spots in many seedlings from this cross, much more dramatic than the one in the photograph. 5" pot. \$15.



**Rlc. Dara Kropfmuller (Rlc. Dream Circle x C. Purple**



**Doll**), recent breeding from SVO, cross #10821. 5" pot. \$20

**Dendrobium gracilicaule**, Australian native, from New South Wales into



Queensland, spicy fragrance, not often seen in SoCal, nice division with good color (some forms are yellow-green, almost unmarked) in 5" pot. \$30.

**Dendrobium Australian Artist**, from SVO, nice specimen, yellow with



red lip. 5" pot. \$25.

---

**Dendrobium Specio-kingianum 'Crysta'**, prolific white cultivar,



popular at shows. 5" pot. \$25.

**Maxillaria tenuifolia**, nice specimens and divisions from Janellm total 7 plants.



Baskets and 6" pots. \$25 each.

**Oncidium NOID**, nice small Oncidium from Janell, 1" flowers on multiple spikes.  
5" basket. \$25.



---

**Tillandsia stricta**, hanging specimen, hardy fall-blooming bromeliad for shady location, grass-like leaves, trouble-free survivor since about 1975. \$15.

**Neofinetia hybrid**, Vanda (Nakamotoara) (V. (Neo.) falcata 'Red Stem' x V. (Nakamotoara) Cinderella 'Hawaii'), Roland Collection ? , never registered. Faint hints of yellow in the flowers. \$15.

**Epidendrum ciliare**, at least 3 plants, 4"-5" pots . \$15 each.



## **Rth. Martha's Sunburst (Lc. Tokyo Life x Pot. Martha**



**Clarke)**, wide range of colors for this cross, ranging from deep purple to yellow and flame colors, mostly with flares. 6" ceramic pot. \$20.

## **Oncidium Wild Willie 'Pacific Bingo'**, vigorous, popular hybrid. 1



gallon pot. \$25.

## **Oncostele Hilo Firecracker 'New Year'**, outstanding Oncidium



intergeneric. 1 gallon pot. \$25.

## **Cymbidiums, no labels**, from Janell's garden. Assorted sizes, \$10 and up.

## **Cymbidium, no label, in spike**. Be surprised! \$20.

**Cattleya Trinette**, hybrid from 1955 (Jacquinetta x Trimos), little known today, likely a 5" white, or possibly purple. At least 4 big plants. \$25 each. Also, two larger specimens to be auctioned.

**Rlc. Yen Corona ‘Green Genie’**, popular compact cattleya hybrid,  
mericlone. 5” pot. \$20.



---

**Lcn. Sensational Value (=Chocolate Drop x anceps!),**



interesting anceps hybrid from Dogashima Orchids, Japan, should be an excellent red on strong spikes, probably 3½” flowers. Some hybrids with this type of breeding have diluted color, more like watermelon shades. 6” pot. \$20.

**Gcy. Kyoguchi x C. Beaufort**, this one takes after the Kyoguchi parent,  
small very cute flowers on a small plant. SVO cross #9822. 5” pot. \$20.

**Plastic Pots 3¼”**, square, perfect for small plants, excellent drainage, raised feet.  
Priced at 8 for \$5.

---

**Plastic Pots 5”**, round, good drainage. Priced at 6 for \$5.

---

**Plastic Pots 6”**, round, good drainage. Priced at 5 for \$5.

---

**Shade Cloth, 50%, 6½' x 10', with grommets.** These tend a bit larger, should last 2-3 seasons. We have 3, priced at \$7 each.

**Cattleya hybrids, unidentified, from Janell's garden.** We don't know what they are, but several are in sheath. About 15 plants. Priced to sell, \$10 to \$25.

**Cattleya aurantiaca 'Helen Congleton', label specifies "magenta bifoliate"**, might be a Guatemalensis or x laelioides? 6" pot. \$35.

**Epicattleya ? NOID**, 6" pot, \$10.

---

**Ctt. Porcia 'Cannizaro'**, repotted divisions, good condition. 7 plants, priced \$25-\$35.



**Cattleya purpurata rubra x self**, seedling. 4" pot. \$20.



**Rlc. Warm Sands (=Amber Glow x Chinese Bronze),** seedling. 5” pot. \$25.

**Rlc. ((Love Sound x Tokyo Magic) x L. anceps),** seedling. 5” pot. \$25.

**Bc. Punakea ‘Pink Delight’,** mericlone. 5” pot. \$25.



---

**Lc. Orchid Affair (C. Horace x Lc. Mari’s Song),** *might* be a mericlone of awarded ‘Ontario’, but the original label is fragmented and incomplete. 5” pot. \$25. Not sure of the vendor. Photo is for AM award of ‘Ontario’, very similar to some cultivars of Lc. Prism Palette.

**Paphiopedilum rothschildianum (‘King Kong’ x**



**‘Humongous’),** this cross is discussed on the internet, one of the last crosses from Orchid Inn (Sam Tsui), a lot of buzz. Seedlings from this cross were offered as late as 2025 from Sunset Valley Orchids. This seedling has a ways to go, but appears to be in good health. A bargain at \$40.
